

PICTIONARY GAME - REPRODUCTION

RULES

- PLAYERS MUST WORK IN PAIRS. (2 OR 3 PAIRS PER GAME)
- WITHIN THE PAIRS THE PLAYERS TAKE TURNS IN DRAWING AND GUESSING THE WORDS.
- ONE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PAIR PICKS UP A CARD FROM THE DECK AND MUST NOT SHOW THEIR PARTNER
- ONCE THIS CARD HAS BEEN SEEN BY THIS PERSON, THE CARD THEN GOES TO THE PERSON IN THE OTHER PAIR THAT IS DRAWING - ONLY THE PEOPLE DRAWING CAN SEE THE CARD
- ONCE THE CARD HAS BEEN SEEN BY ALL PEOPLE THAT ARE DRAWING THE TIMER IS STARTED AND DRAWING BEGINS.
- THE OTHER MEMBER OF THE PAIR MUST THEN TRY TO GUESS WHAT THEIR PARTNER IS DRAWING - REMEMBER IT IS RELATED TO YOUR BIOLOGY WORK.....
- THE FIRST PAIR TO GUESS THE CORRECT ANSWER IS THE WINNER
- TO CALCULATE THE POINTS FOR YOUR PAIR ADD ONE POINT TO YOUR SCORE EVERY TIME YOU ARE THE FIRST TO WIN.
